Bachelor of Science in Nursing Pre-licensure Program Level 1 Fingerprint Clearance Card Requirement

If you are accepted into the Bachelor of Science in Nursing Program, you will be required to have a current DPS Fingerprint Clearance Card to meet clinical requirements. Fingerprint cards are valid for a period of six years. If you have a Fingerprint Card issued more than six years ago, it will need to be renewed. If you have a current Fingerprint Card, please let us know so that we can log it into your file.

Fingerprint Card Application Instructions:

- 1) Follow this link https://www.azdps.gov/services/public/fingerprint and select Apply For a Card.
- 2) Select *Apply for a Fingerprint Clearance Card* and then select *Continue* on the Fingerprint Clearance Card tab.
- 3) Click *Apply for a Card* and continue to follow the instructions as prompted by the AZ DPS website.
- 4) Please note that you will have two options for the fingerprinting itself paper or electronic. Electronic fingerprinting is only available if the applicant is physically present in Arizona
