Frequently Asked Questions

Q: How long should I expect to be on the Pending Selection List?

A: Students pending selection will receive a timeslot to access their Housing Application and select an available bed.

Q: How will I know I have received a selection timeslot?

A: You will receive a selection timeslot email to your GCU email account. This date and time can also be viewed within your Housing Portal.

Q: What do I do after I receive my pending selection timeslot email?

A: Follow the instructions in the email, which will include selecting your booking, meal plan, signing your housing contract and completing your housing application.

Q: My friend currently lives on campus, can I select a bed in their suite?

A: You might be able to live with your friend if there is a bed available in their suite for you to select. Please note, this is not guaranteed.

Q: My friend and I are both applying for Spring Only, can we select beds in the same suite?

A: Students can coordinate at their timeslot to select two beds together. If none are available, you can utilize Room Switch until Dec. 1, 2026.

Q: What if I do not like my room after I select my booking?

A: Students will be able to access the Room Switch page, located in their housing application, to switch their rooms until Dec. 1, 2026.

Q: What should I do if I no longer want to live on campus for the Spring 2027 semester?

A: If you no longer plan to live on campus, you must submit a Housing Cancellation Form, located in the Housing Portal. If you have been placed in or selected a bed, please review the [Housing Cancellation Deadlines](#).
