

# LIFE GROUPS FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

**Q: WHO CAN ATTEND LIFE GROUPS?**

**A:** Any current traditional campus student at GCU can attend a Life Group.

**Q: CAN COMMUTERS ATTEND LIFE GROUPS?**

**A:** Absolutely! We even have some Life Groups scheduled at times that may work well with your unique schedules.

**Q: DO I HAVE TO ATTEND THE LIFE GROUP IN MY HALL?**

**A:** While we hope the Life Group in your hall will be a good fit, you are welcome to attend any of the Life Groups on campus.

**Q: ARE LIFE GROUPS COED?**

**A:** Not at this time. We have specific groups for men and women.

**Q: HOW DO I BECOME A LIFE LEADER?**
