

IMMUNIZATION FORM

Immunization Confirmation/Exemption

Students who live on campus must provide verification of current immunity to measles, mumps and rubella (MMR) and meningitis A. Evidence of two MMRs as a child (one at one year of age and one after age four), two MMRs as an adult (not less than 30 days apart), a meningococcal conjugate vaccine (given within five years prior to applying for student housing) or lab tests demonstrating immunity may be uploaded to the student's checklist. The MMR immunization requirements are waived for those students who were born before Jan. 1, 1957.

Please note: Once the documents have been uploaded, expect 2-3 business days for the documents to be processed and access to the housing application to be provided.

Students without confirmation of or exemption from immunization will not be permitted to register for campus housing. Further, in the event of an outbreak of measles, mumps, rubella or meningitis for which students cannot provide proof of immunity, permission to attend school and live or remain on campus will be rescinded until the risk period ends, even if an exemption were previously granted. Students participating in short-term residencies or other periodic, low-repetition activities may be exempt from the immunization policy. All exemptions are issued at the sole discretion of Grand Canyon University.

Laboratory Evidence

If you have previously had a vaccine preventable disease, immunization against that disease is not required if laboratory evidence of immunity, signed by a physician can be provided. *Copies of lab results must accompany this request.*

Statement of Exemption

There are some consequences if immunization(s) is/are waived by the student including quarantine in the event of outbreak of any disease. All exemptions are issued at the sole discretion of Grand Canyon University.

Quarantine Policy

Under the quarantine policy in the event of an outbreak of any disease for which you are not immunized as required by the college, you will be asked to leave campus until two incubation periods have passed after the last case has been diagnosed. Students quarantined from campus are not eligible for tuition, room or board refunds and may suffer academic consequences if class/lab attendance is necessary to meet course requirements.
